TLTI Lip Sync Battle Rules & Regulations

1. Registration is open to the first 10 entries that complete online registration form.
2. Teams can range in size from 1 to 8 people. Eligible team members include TLTI attendees (Students, advisors, staff, and administration) All team member names must be included on the registration form. Only individuals listed on the registration form can perform.
3. Individuals can only compete in one act
4. Teams may use props; these props must be included on the registration form to be approved by the *TLTI Show Off Your Skills Committee*. Props not included on registration form cannot be used in the performance. **Fog machines, bubble machines, fire, water, and glitter are prohibited.** Microphones will be provided.
5. Music must be submitted with registration form to be approved by the *TLTI Show Off Your Skills Committee*. Songs must be the clean version; no explicit versions will be accepted. Failure to submit music may result in the team's registration being cancelled. Teams will be notified whether they have been approved to participate.
6. The maximum time limit is four minutes per performance. After four minutes, the music will fade out.
7. The *TLTI Show Off Your Skills Committee* reserves the right to cancel registration if the committee feels the act is inappropriate or offensive to others. If an offensive act is performed, the *TLTI Show Off Your Skills Committee* reserves the right to terminate the performance and the act will be disqualified.

Judging Criteria:

- A. **Lip Sync Abilities:** How well the performer(s) lip-sync the lyrics of the song.
- B. **Creativity:** How original and creative the performance is. Instead of just standing on stage and lip-syncing a song - props, choreography, costumes and/or other ideas should be used and often impresses the judges and generates crowd response. Be creative!
- C. **Stage Presence & Choreography:** Again, don't just stand there! Engage the audience, dance, smile, make eye contact with the judges...**SHOW OFF YOUR SKILLS** ---have fun!

Each category will be worth 15 points each. In case of a tie, the act with the highest lip sync score will win.

The judges' decisions are final.

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners!

TLTI Karaoke Competition Rules & Regulations

1. Registration is open to the first 10 individuals that complete online registration form.
2. Because this is a Karaoke contest, contestants must sing Karaoke songs. They are not required to read lyrics from a TV monitor, but the back track must be an original work from another original artist. Singing acapella without such music would not constitute “karaoke” and could, therefore, lead to disqualification.
3. Props may be used, but no additional singers are allowed during the performance
4. Music must be submitted with registration form to be approved by the *TLTI Show Off Your Skills Committee*. Songs must be the clean version; no explicit versions will be accepted. Failure to submit music may result in the registration being cancelled. Individuals will be notified whether they have been approved to participate.
5. The *TLTI Show Off Your Skills Committee* reserves the right to cancel registration if the committee feels the act is inappropriate or offensive to others. If an offensive act is performed, the *TLTI Show Off Your Skills Committee* reserves the right to terminate the performance and the act will be disqualified.

The competition will be judged on these categories:

Judging Criteria:

- A. **Vocal Performance**- Did the singer stay in time with the music, and choose a song suited to his/her ability?
- B. **Creativity**: Did singer have his/her own style, or did he/she mimic the original well (either is fine).
- C. **Stage**: Did the singer draw the crowd and you as a judge into the performance? Was the singer enthusiastic/emotionally in sync with the song? Was the singer confident on stage? Remember to **SHOW OFF YOUR SKILLS!** Have fun!

Each category will be worth 15 points each. In case of a tie, the act with the highest Vocal Performance score will win.

The judges’ decisions are final.

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners!
