



AMERICAN SPIRIT CONTEST

OVERVIEW

The American Spirit contest evaluates local chapter activities for community service, citizenship projects and those with patriotic overtones that demonstrate a belief in the American way of life.

THE CONTEST

- For this contest chapters must conduct three separate projects that demonstrate community service, patriotism and citizenship, and promotion of career and technical education. Only one project per category may be entered. Students must plan, organize, prepare and execute all projects within the current competition school year.
- The contest will consist of two parts: an electronic notebook documenting the chapter projects and a presentation by the chapter team to a panel of judges via electronic platform.
- Contestants must create a one-page résumé and submit via electronic upload. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.

CONTEST SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

- Contest items must be submitted electronically through the contest submission form. Notebook in PDF format should be included.
- Contestants will receive a specified date/time and login credentials to participate in the virtual portion of the contest via electronic platform with a panel of judges. Contestants should be dressed in professional business attire or SkillsUSA attire for this session.

DEADLINE

All contest items must be received by Tuesday, February 15, 2022, through the contest submission form.
