



COMMUNITY SERVICE CONTEST

OVERVIEW

The Community Service contest evaluates local chapter activities that benefit the community and recognizes excellence and professionalism in the area of community service. This event also enables the community to become aware of the outstanding work being performed by career and technical education students.

THE CONTEST

- The contest will consist of two parts: an electronic notebook outlining the chapter community service project and a live presentation by the chapter team.
- The chapter will organize the year's community service activities and present its best community service project to a panel of judges. Team members will have seven to ten minutes to present to a panel of judges via electronic platform. Only one project may be presented.
- The notebook and presentation should represent a community service project that was conceived, planned and completed during the current school year.
- Contestants must create a one-page résumé and submit via electronic upload. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.

CONTEST SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

- Contest items must be submitted electronically through the contest submission form. Notebook in PDF format should be included.
- Contestants will receive a specified date/time and login credentials to participate in the virtual portion of the contest via electronic platform with a panel of judges. Contestants should be dressed in professional business attire or SkillsUSA attire for this session.

DEADLINE

All contest items must be received by Tuesday, February 15, 2022, through the contest submission form.
