



## **OUTSTANDING CHAPTER CONTEST**

### **OVERVIEW**

The Outstanding Chapter contest evaluates local chapter activities that benefit the student members, the school and the community. The outstanding chapters chosen each year serve as an example of the enthusiasm and careful planning necessary to keep chapters active and to involve as many members in activities as possible.

### **THE CONTEST**

- The contest assesses a chapter's ability to effectively plan, organize, implement and record activities related to its annual program of work.
- The chapter will organize the year's activities and record them in an electronic notebook. (See SkillsUSA Technical Standards)
- Each team will be interviewed. All three team members must be present during the interview. Students will have an opportunity to explain how they approached various activities and how the Outstanding Chapter project benefited their class and/or school. The interview will be used to help verify points awarded by the judges and to answer any questions they may have. The interview with the judges will be approximately 10 minutes. The interview will be conducted via virtual platform with a panel of judges.
- Contestants must create a one-page résumé and submit via electronic upload. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.

### **CONTEST SUBMISSION PROCEDURES**

- Contest items must be submitted electronically through the contest submission form.
- Contestants will receive a specified date/time and login credentials to participate in the virtual portion of the contest via electronic platform with a panel of judges. Contestants should be dressed in professional business attire or SkillsUSA attire for this session.

### **DEADLINE**

All contest items must be received by Tuesday, February 15, 2022, through the contest submission form.
